EXCLUSION TYPES

A suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19 in our school community would lead to one of the following situations.

ISOLATION: separating people with a confirmed case of COVID-19 from others who are not sick.

QUARANTINE: separating or restricting movements of people exposed to COVID-19 to see if they become sick.

EXCLUSION SITUATIONS

Isolation or guarantine situations would be scaled to meet the confirmed or potential disease spread.



Moved to remote learning. Campus exclusion for 2 weeks or until two negative COVID-19 tests completed.



Moved to e-learning with alternative schedule.

Campus exclusion for 2 weeks or until two negative COVID-19 tests completed.



Moved to e-learning with alternative schedule.

Campus exclusion timeline determined on case by case basis.

ACTION STEPS

An exclusion situation involving an ISI student, faculty, or staff member would trigger the following steps.



Case reported to ISI certified contact tracer/school nurse according to Student, Faculty, or Staff Illness policy.



Impacted individual immediately excluded from campus according to Student, Faculty, or Staff Illness policy, along with any family members who are ISI students or employees, while awaiting test results.



Required reporting to local and state health officials completed by ISI leadership and certified contact tracer.



Health officials and ISI certified contact tracer determine need for any additional exclusions by individual, cohort, pod, or building.



Confirmation email delivered to members of ISI community as appropriate by the exclusion situation scale that is determined by health officials and ISI certified contact tracer.
