TUITION INCLUDES:

Cost of Lunch

Students receive a hot lunch every day. Vegetarian options available. A full salad bar is available to all grades, and a deli and soup counter is available at the High School.

Books

All needed books for every grade are included in tuition.

Technology Fees

Fees are used to fund IT support, classroom sets of iPads at the Lower School, standardized testing Chromebooks at the Upper School, and other support for in-person and remote learning as needed.

Activity Fees

In-school club activities are free to students. Some examples of clubs at ISI include: various art clubs, Black Student Union, Coding, Model UN, SAT Math Prep, culture clubs, Yearbook and more.

Local Field Trips

Lower School students go on multiple field trips a year, including visits to local museums, BizTown, and nature centers.

Student Support Services

SSS works with students to identify and reach academic, social, and emotional goals through collaboration between students, their teachers, and families.

Parent Association Support

The PA assists in planning and managing volunteer support for some of the most important ISI community events each year.

College Counseling Services

College Counseling at ISI begins in Grade 9. Activities included in tuition include (but are not limited to):

- One-on-one and group meetings with counselor
- National College Fair attendance
- Resume, application, essay, and interview workshops
- PSAT and PSAT practice meetings
- Scholarship search support
- In-school visits from 60-100 universities yearly

*Typically trips have been required as a part of curriculum with the most recent prices ranging from \$1,200 - \$3,900. ISI is assessing how exchange trips can be offered in the 2022-2023 school year given uncertainties worldwide related to travel, visa issuance, and insurance and prices may vary from previous year's cost. We are working closely with international and domestic program partners to explore opportunities. In September of 2022 we will determine whether Spring 2023 travel is viable, and at what cost and requirements.
